



Pavement Marking/Striping Equipment

On-Site Maintenance & Training Program

Improve overall performance and extend product life with routine factory maintenance.

Scope of Work:

- Run for proper operations
- Remove paint plumbing - clean and reinstall
- Clean all screens in paint filters and manifolds
- Inspect the gaskets on the paint tank lids
- Disassemble paint guns - inspect and clean
- Inspect and clean heat exchangers
- Check regulators and gauges for proper operation
- Test all systems for leaks and proper operation
- Recalibrate skip line over a measured course

Owner Responsibilities:

- Remove of all the paint from the paint system
 - Flush water through the entire paint system from the paint tanks through the paint guns
 - Drain the flush water out of the system, purging it with air to get as much of the water out as possible.
 - Immediately after blowing the system dry with air, add 25 gallons of RV antifreeze to each paint tank
 - With low pressure on the tanks, purge both yellow and white systems with RV antifreeze through the entire system, through the paint guns
 - Remove all the water from the flush tank
 - Blow the system out with air until dry and purge with RV antifreeze
- Communicate any known issues to MB prior to technician's arrival

Additional/required parts available for purchase.

Labor and parts installed by the MB Technician will be covered by our factory warranty for the period of one year from date of installation.

Travel and expenses additional if incurred.
